To Whom It May Concern:

Law Treats All Diplomas Equally

On August 8, 2017, the bipartisan-supported HB2389 became Arizona law. It states:

“This state, any political subdivision or agency of this state and any other governmental entity shall recognize and treat all diplomas and transcripts associated with schooling options as described in section 15-802 in the same manner. School districts may evaluate the transcripts of transfer students for the assignment of credit pursuant to section 15-701.01.”

The law requires all state, county, and city governmental agencies in the state of Arizona including organizations working on behalf of these agencies to treat all homeschool, public school, charter school, private school, and empowerment scholarship contract school diplomas and transcripts in the same manner. This includes access to all public colleges and universities, government required certifications, and employment.

Information can be found in the Arizona Revised Statutes General Provisions Article 1-701.
